

Hungkuang University: "Career Enhancement & Employment Support for International Students" Program

1. Operating Procedures

- 1.1 Assist international students in conducting competency diagnostics. Utilize personality trait assessments and career competency card sorts, combined with student self-evaluations, to help students identify and define their career development paths.
- 1.2 The Career Development Center shall organize "Career Workshops," "Resume Writing and Interview Skills Courses," and "Labor Rights Awareness Seminars." These initiatives are designed to cultivate employment awareness, provide insights into industry trends, and integrate academic learning with career planning to enhance students' overall job readiness.
- 1.3 Request participating departments to provide job openings from partner industries. Review both employer requirements and student profiles to ensure compliance with the **Points System for Foreign Graduated Students to Work in Taiwan**. Provide active job-matching assistance for graduating seniors.
- 1.4 Conduct graduate destination surveys to monitor and record the subsequent employment status of international alumni.
